INITIAL VISIT INTRODUCTION

Welcome. Dr. Monica Kieffer is an osteopathic physician or D.O. (Doctor of Osteopathy). D.O.s have equal training and licensing to M.D.s and practice in the same manner and specialties as M.D.s. Traditional osteopathic medicine restores balance to the structure and improves function of the whole body using Osteopathic Manipulative Medicine (OMM). Dr. Kieffer has been board certified in Neuromusculoskeletal medicine or OMM since 1997. The body can become imbalanced or injured due to physical, biochemical, or emotional trauma. OMM is a gentle balancing force applied to release twisting and compression of the soft tissue, bones, muscles, and organs, enabling normal motion of the bodily membranes and fluids. Ultimately this improved motion can improve the function of the muscles, nerves, skeletal structure, and even the organs of the body. In a holistic sense Dr. Kieffer also believes in addressing psychospiritual and nutritional aspects of disease.
